



## Institutional Free ship and Fee Concession Policy

### 1. Institutional Context

Fairfield Institute of Management & Technology (FIMT) is committed to promoting equitable access to higher education and ensuring that deserving students are not deprived of educational opportunities due to financial constraints. In pursuance of its vision of inclusive education and student welfare, the institution has instituted an Institutional Freeship and Fee Concession Policy.

### 2. Objective

The objectives of this policy are to:

- Promote access, equity, and inclusiveness in higher education
- Provide need-based and merit-based financial assistance to deserving students
- Reduce financial barriers at the entry level of higher education
- Encourage participation and retention of students from diverse socio-economic backgrounds

### 3. Nature of the Scheme

Under this policy, the institution provides full or partial freeship / fee concession funded by the institution. The financial support is extended at the time of admission and is institutional in nature.

### 4. Eligibility Criteria

Students may be considered for freeship or fee concession based on one or more of the following criteria:

- Economic background of the student
- Academic merit and past performance
- Social inclusion and special circumstances
- Any other criteria as approved by the competent authority of the institution

### 5. Identification and Approval

Eligible students are identified at the time of admission based on predefined criteria and documentary evidence. Applications are scrutinized by the Admission Committee and approved by the competent institutional authority, ensuring transparency and fairness in the process.

### 6. Implementation and Record Maintenance

The Admission Department is responsible for implementing the policy. Approved concessions are reflected in the fee structure, and proper year-wise records of beneficiaries are maintained for academic and statutory purposes.
