
Report of Two day Workshop




#### REPORT OF THE EVENT

The Session first series was started on 8th April 2023 (Saturday) wing -A Auditorium with the welcomed and introduction of guest speaker by Prof. (Dr.) S.P Singh, Academic Head- FIMT. The first session was on the topic Self Introduction, SMART Goals and SWOT Analysis and the guest speaker was Ms. Shilpi Aggarwal, Professional communication Skill trainer. Ms Shilpi Started session with a round of introductions as an 'ice breaker': as a minimum everyone in the group should take turns to state their name and describe themselves with an adjective.




