M/s Sony India Pvt Ltd.

Ashwani and M/s better deal (State Consumer Commission, Delhi)

....RESPONDENT

BRIEF FACTS:-

1. *Respondent purchased one TV set of Sony on 03/05/2002 with a warranty valid till 02/05/2003.*
2. *Since the beginning TV set was giving trouble and was of a poor quality. Respondent 1 lodged a complaint with respondent 2 and they visited Respondent 1 on 12/12/2002 and 23/03/2003 to remove the fault and an antenna was also installed as the prescribed height as said by the technician. Still there was no improvement in the quality.*
3. *Respondent 1 prayed in front of the Forum to direct Sony India to either replace the said defective TV set or to refund Rs 23,500/- along with litigation charges and compensation.*
4. *Applicant took a plea that the TV set is completely perfect and does not have any*

manufacturing defect. As per Applicant, its fault of Doordarshan which is transmitting low quality of audio and video signals.

- 5. As per Consumer Protection Act, Sec 2(1)(D), clearly describes the word "DEFECT", in such a manner that any goods particularly a brand new goods should not suffer from any kind of shortcoming, inadequacy in any manner of performance.*
- 6. It was also observed by the commission that the attitude of the applicant was not consumer friendly and to assume that all the purchasers of the TV set will have the facility of cable connection was illogical.*
- 7. In Lacknow Development Authority V/SM.S.Gupta, 1994(1) SCC 243, Supreme court stated:-
"to begin with preamble of the act, which can afford useful assistance to ascertain the legislative intention, it was enacted to provide for the protection in interest of consumers."*
- 8. It attempts to remove helplessness of a consumer which he faces against powerful, business, described as, 'a network of rackets' or a society in which Producers have secured power to rob the rest.*

OBSERVATION :-

Forum decided that Applicant to pay back the amount of the TV set to Respondent 1 and also to pay Rs 10,000/- as mental agony caused due to litigation process.

BRIEF FACTS:-

1. *The petitioner, Tarun Wadhwa and the respondent, Anushka Wadhwa came into contact through a social networking site and decided to marry each other.*
2. *Out of this wedlock, they had one issue.*
3. *It is important to note the fact that the Respondent was Previously Married.*
4. *This fact came to the knowledge of the petitioner after six months of his marriage with the respondent.*
5. *That whenever the plaintiff tried to confront the respondent about her previous marriage and why she hides such a fact, she used to change the topic or give vague excuses or say that she will suffer through mental trauma by discussing that chapter of her life.*
6. *The respondent often used to leave home without informing the petitioner, and remained outside for whole day and sometimes even at night as well.*
7. *The plaintiff one day asked for the respondent's mobile phone which she handed over reluctantly and the plaintiff came across various adult texts and images sent by her lover.*

Prayer :-

The plaintiff seeks divorce under section 13(1)(ia) from the respondent and also the custody of the child.

OBSERVATION :-

Divorce was granted as respondent's behavior towards marriage was found unacceptable. Custody of the child is granted to petitioner, but court allowed the Respondent to meet the child once a week.

Dishonoured due to insufficient funds.*

Dear Sir,

Under instructions and authority from our client Mr. Vaibhav Yadav having his office at 2-A, Nagafghar Road, Moti Nagar Main, New Delhi, we serve upon you the following notice of demand under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

- 1. That you had purchased from my client Ceat Tyres vide their invoice bearing no. 7910 dated 03/10/2019 for Rs. 2,80,000/-.*
 - a. On delivery of goods above mentioned, you issued a cheque bearing no. 915326 dated 05/10/2019 for Rs. 2,80,000/- drawn on HDFC Bank, Karol Bagh Branch.*
 - b. That when the aforesaid cheque was presented by our client to your Bankers i.e. HDFC Bank, Karol Bagh branch, the same was returned unpaid by the Bank with the remarks/reasons "Insufficient Funds". This fact was brought to your notice by our client vide letter dated 11/10/2019.*
 - c. That in reply to our client's letter, you sent a letter dated 16/10/2019 requesting him to deposit the cheque again with banker and assured him that they will be cleared this time.*
 - d. My client again presented your above mentioned cheque with his bankers, this time again cheque was returned un-paid by the bank due to insufficient funds.*
 - e. That thereafter in spite of many telephonic reminders and personal visits by the representative of our client to your office, you failed to make the payment due to our client.*
 - f. That on account of the above facts, you are liable to be prosecuted under section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act, 1881 as amended up to date under which you are*

liable to be punished with imprisonment which may extend to one year or with fine which may extend to twice the amount of cheque or with both.

Under the circumstances, we call upon you to make the payment of Rs. 2,80,000/- being the principal amount of the aforesaid cheque along with interest @ 24 % per annum till the time of actual payment within a period of 15 (fifteen) days from the date of receipt of this notice, failing which we will be bound to take further necessary action under the provisions of Negotiable Instrument Act, 1881 against you in the competent court of law at your risk and cost.

BRIEF FACTS:-

1. That the marriage of the complainant was solemnized with respondent no. 1 on 24th November 2016 as per Hindu Rites and Ceremonies.
2. That right from the beginning of the marriage of the complainant with the accused no.

1, he and his family members were harassing and demanding from the complainant for more Dowry articles.

3. That the accused no.1 in connivance with the other accused conspired to file the Divorce Petition in the court when the complainant is still living with the accused no.1 in the matrimonial house.
4. That the complainant had no clue about the petition for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce under section 13(1)(ia) of Hindu Marriage Act 1955, filed by the respondent no.-1 while she was residing in the matrimonial house.
5. That on 04.04.2018 complainant's mother-in-law taunted the complainant for a petty reason and stopped her to sue the kitchen and "**Is Doodh kochhun ekikoshishmat karna**". The Complainant was quiet but respondent no 3 was murmuring. In the due course of time respondent no 1 arrived and hold the complainant's hair and dragged her mercilessly and threw her out from the kitchen and said that "**Merimaase jubaan chalti hai**". The Complainant said that she didn't say anything, just asking for milk then respondent no 1 slapped the complainant 2 to 4 times and forcibly pushed the complainant out from the house. Respondent no. 1 abused the complainant and used abusive words against the complainant. That respondent no 1 stayed at the ground floor with the other respondents but always make nuisance whenever the Complainant asked to bring good ingredients. Respondent no 1 also said "**Meneteri jimmedariyokathekanahilerakha**". The complainant was further directed to ask her parent to bring all livelihood ingredients and basic amenities.
6. That the complainant was not allowed to go to her parents' home. Only after the daughter namely Gaurvi was 6 years old, then the complainant started to visit her parents' home. Respondent no 1 did not used to give money.
7. That respondent no 3 of the complainant asked to the complainant that your brother is a property dealer so ask him to give a flat to respondent no 1. As the complainant had not given dowry in her marriage but now, at least, give a flat as a dowry to respondent no 1.

8. *That In-laws family members have been torturing more, mentally and sometime physically, since Gauravi was born. respondent no 1 and respondent no 3 always taunted for being born of a girl because they wanted a boy. respondent no 3 always says that the complainant ruins all his desires and reputation in the society as everyone around us have given birth of a boy and the complainant gave a girl child. In-laws family never expected and blamed on the complainant for giving birth of a girl child.*
9. *That on 19.01.2019, on the occasion of birthday of the daughter of the complainant namely Gauravi complainant's maternal family members come. But respondent no 1, in his anger, went before them and shouted, without eye contact, "Kisne bulayatum sabko hamareyaha". The complainant's mother had brought 5 gold jewelries and 2 silver jewelries. But that was not enough to fulfill the greediness of respondent no 1 respondent no 2 & 3 they told that the complainant's parents should have given, at least, a car or a golden chain to respondent no 1. respondent no 1 told the complainant that your family member ruins our party/function and why did they come here.*
10. *That the respondent no 3 always used to say to the complainant that she wants a boy and for this repeatedly asked to go for the checkup.*
11. *That the respondent no 3 used to taunt the complainant that she was not educated if she was then definitely she will work for her livelihood and won't eat free of cost.*
12. *That respondent no 1 has already told to the complainant that you get out from my house even with your child, Gauravi, or without child. But leave anyhow from here.*

It is therefore prayed that the Hon'ble Court may take the cognizance of the complaint/domestic incident report and pass any other or further orders as deemed necessary in the circumstances of the case.

ORDER/RELIEF REQUIRED:

1. Protection Order U/s 18:

- *Pass Protection Order U/s 18 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, prohibiting acts of domestic violence by granting injunction against the respondents from repeating any of the Acts of violence mentioned in the complaint of the complainant.*
- *Prohibiting any form of the communication by the respondents with the complainant:*
- *Prohibiting alienation of estridhan/assets/jewellery by the respondents.*
- *Directing the respondents to stay away from the dependants/relatives/any other person of the aggrieved person to prohibit violence against them.*
- *Prohibiting respondents from entering the residence.*

2. *Residence order U/s 19:*

- *Pass order restraining the respondents from entering the house/Room of the complainant.*
- *Alienating/dispossessing/encumbering the shared household*
- *Renouncing her rights in the shared household.*
- *An order directing respondent(s) to secure it level of alternate accommodation or pay rent of Rs. 5,500/- for the same.*

3. *Monetary relief under Section 20:-*

- *Medical Expenses, Amount claimed Rs. 4,000/- per month.*
- *Loss of mental injury Rs. 5,00,000/-*
- *Monthly and other basic amenities Rs. 8,000/- per month.*
- *Monthly expenses of child studies of Rs. 5,000/- per month.*

4. *Compensation order under Section 22:-*

Compensation for running the life of the complainant, damage for mental injuries, emotion and distress caused by the acts of the domestic violence committed by the respondents Rs. 8,00,000/-

2. *That on dt.06/08/2018 the accused person approached the complainant and requested forafriendlyloan ofRs.70,000(SeventyThousand Only)and Rs.1,10,000(onelakhten thousand only)foraperiod ofoneyear,duetofriendly relation,thecomplainantagreedtotherequestsoftheaccusedandhandedoverthe sumofRs.70,000/-(seventyThousandOnly)andRs.1,10,000(onelakhtenthousand only) to accused person. It is pertinent to mention here that as per the said agreement the complainant was to pay the loan in an easy installments within one year.Thesamewasalsodocumentedinanagreementdated06/08/2018stampno. **IN-DL61504644316639Q** and another agreement dated 29/08/2018 stamp no. **IN-DL70898175094270Q**colly.*
3. *Thatlatertheaccusedhavenotcomeupwiththeanysinglepaymentafterwardsand was totally avoiding the complainant to make the monthly payment to the complainant.*
4. *That the accused had provided two cheques bearing no. 203969 of amount Rs. 1,10,000andno.203970ofamountRs.70,000ofInduslandBankasasecuritytothe complainant for any kind of non-payment from the accused side. That the accused then sold one vehicle Xcent bearing no.DL1YE6487 chasis no. MALA841CLFM097684 Engine no. G4LAFM637116 Model no. 2015 on dated 29/08/2018 and the NOC was alsopreparedbytheaccusedpersonandhandedovertothecomplainantonthesame day.ThesaidNOCspecificallymentionsthatthefullandfinalpaymenthasbeenmade bytheaccusedtothecomplainant.*
5. *That on 09/09/2018 the accused came up to the complainant and prayed that heis verypoorandcouldnotabletocomeupwiththepaymentsaspromisedbyhimthus bynumerousrequestmadebytheaccusedforanopportunitytoallowtheaccusedto use the car for professional use so that the accused can earn the money for household use and repayment of the loan of the complainant to which the complainant agreed as the complainant also wanted to get his money back andthe*

complainant gave another chance to the accused in good faith.

- 6. That the accused have handed over two cheques as a security to the complainant for any kind of non-payment from the accused. The accused also assured the complainant that if any non-payment happened then the complainant can present those cheques for the encashment at any time. The Accused also confirmed while handing over the cheques that cheque bearing no. 203969 and 203970 is given as a security for handing over the vehicle and cheque bearing no. 203969 is given for the security for the loan amount of Rs 70,000/- and cheque bearing no. 203970 is given for the loan amount of Rs. 1,10,000/. That on 27/06/2019 on accused's assurance the complainant had presented the aforesaid cheque for the encashment with his bank namely Central Bank of India, vikaspuri New Delhi-110018 however to the utter shock and dismay of the complainant the same were returned unpaid with the remarks "FUNDS INSUFFICIENT"*
- 7. That the complainant also paid the remaining installments of the vehicle sold by the accused but the accused did not receive any money from the accused side.*
- 8. That after taking the possession of the vehicle the accused was avoiding the complainant and whenever the complainant tried to get in contact with the accused, the accused never responded to his calls and messages.*
- 9. That the complainant waited for almost one year, but still the accused paid no heed to the complainant's calls and thus all efforts of the complainant gone in vain and then the complainant went to the local police station i.e. P.S. Vikaspuri and filed one complaint dated 02/05/2019 with DD no. 41A.*
- 10. That the complainant had been running from pillar to post to get in contact with the accused but the accused have been avoiding the same.*
- 11. That it is crystal clear from the act of the accused that the intention of the accused have turned out to be mala fide by issuing the aforesaid cheques despite knowing the fact that there were no sufficient funds or balance in the account of the accused thus the accused have committed an offence punishable under Negotiable Instrument Act as well as IPC.*
- 12. That the aforesaid cheque amount is recoverable by the complainant from the accused before the civil as well as criminal court of law. That the amount of cheque in question is legally recoverable and enforceable debt and liability of the accused but he has turned a deaf ear.*

13. *That admittedly the accused is under legal liability to repay the amount of cheque in question as he has taken the same.*
14. *That the accused had issued the cheque in question to the complainant intentionally and deliberately out of his malafide intention with intent to cheat the complainant and to defraud him, knowingly fully well that the cheque in question is not going to clear as he knows the fact that he has not sufficient fund in his account.*
15. *That on finding no other alternative the complainant got issued a legal demand notice dt. 01/07/2019 through his advocate on the correct address of the accused, where he is presently residing, as mentioned in memo of parties through speed post and the legal notice is duly served by the accused. It is pertinent to mention here that the accused has not paid a single penny to the complainant towards the cheque in question till date.*
16. *That the complainant has complied with all the provisions of section 138R/W142 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 with upto date amendments. The bank of the accused INDUSLAND BANK branch janakpuri, New Delhi -58 where the cheque in question was presented for encashment and got dishonoured which lies in P.S. Vikaspuri, new delhi within the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court, and hence this Hon'ble Court has jurisdiction to deal with present complaint.*
17. *That no other complaint/suit is pending w.r.t. to cheque in question before any court of law in India.*
18. *That no other case is pending between the same parties to the complaint. That the complaint has been filed within period of limitation.*

PRAYER:

It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that accused may please be summoned, tried and punished according to the relevant provisions of law and compensation may please be awarded to the complainant equivalent to double of the cheque amount and any other order(s) or relief(s) may also be passed which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice.

OBSERVATION:-

I along with junior advocate filed the above case in the Facilitation Center.

There is no other Class-I legal heir except as stated above. Deceased had not executed any Will during her lifetime.*
4. *PW-1 further stated that deceased Smt. Sushila Nagar had a Senior Citizen Account No.4240767 (New No.8788543144) with Post Office Jungpura, New Delhi. Photocopy of passbook in respect of said post office account is Mark-A (colly-3 pages). PW-1 furnished copy of her Aadhar card as proof of identity. Photocopy of the same is Ex.PW1/3. Original of the same was returned after perusal.*
5. *Statement of Sh. Prakash Chand, PRI (P), Jungpura Post office, New Delhi was recorded on 29.09.2016 wherein he produced the details in respect of a Senior Citizen Account bearing 8788543144 in the name of Ms. Sushila, having balance of Rs.1,66,099/- as on date. The details along with account opening form and other relevant documents are Ex.RW2/1 (colly-5 pages) bearing signatures of Smt. Janak Malhotra, Sub Post Master and seal of the office at point A on each page. He furnished copy of his office I-card as proof of identity and the same is Ex.RW2/2. Original of the same was returned after perusal.*

6. *Statement of Ms. Shweta Garg, counsel for respondent no. 3, Enrollment No. D-598A/02, Chamber No. 486, Saket Court, New Delhi was recorded on 23.01.2017 wherein he stated that he is the counsel for respondent no. 3 Mrs. Sunita Pandya in the present case and he has instructions from the respondent no. 3 to state that the respondent no. 3 has no objection if succession certificate is granted in favour of the petitioner in respect of debts and securities of the deceased Smt. Sushila Nagar. NOC on behalf of respondent no. 3 is already on record same is Ex. RW3/1 bearing signature of respondent no. 3 at point A. She filed vakalatnama on behalf of respondent no. 3. OBSERVATION:-
