Students shall be given ten minute's time to make a convincing argument on any of the above mentioned themes.



# **GUIDELINES OF DECLAMATION CONTEST**

#### GENERAL RULES

- The Declamation Competition shall be held on 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2022 at 12:30 pm at Multipurpose Hall, Wing A of FIMT.
- Reporting time for participants is 12:20 pm.
- Topic for the declamation is communicated via official notice on the college website.
- Last date of registration is 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2022 12:20 pm.
- Participants have to strictly adhere to the reporting time and for speaking time during the competition. Non compliance to the same may result in deducting your overall marks by 0.5.
- Participants may refer to their notes which should be in a physical form. Internet, Mobiles, I pads,
  Laptops, E-notes and any other such means are strictly prohibited during the competition. Non
  compliance for the same may result in cancellation of your participation and it will be on the
  discretion of the Hon'ble judges and their orders will be binding.
- The top three positions shall be decided solely be based upon the marks allotted to them by the
  judges. Marks will be allotted to the participants on certain parameters specified later in this rule
  book and it will be on the complete discretion of the judges, no changes can be made to it and it will
  be binding upon the participants.
- The top three positions shall be awarded with certificate and a pocket constitution.
- All participants will get E-certificate for their active participation in the competition for which the
  participants have to fill a Google form circulated after the competition.

   Speaking skills, 2. Logic in the arguments, 3. Formal Etiquettes,
- Official Language for the debate competition will be ENGLISH only. Kindly stick to the rules for better learning experience.
- No personal remark or inflammatory words are allowed, non compliance to the same may result in disqualification of the participants. Strictly adhere to the rules of declamation competition for your better learning experience.
- Dress code shall be college uniform and should be strictly adhered to.
