





- Meets The Prescribed Medical Standards.
- Must Fulfil All Required Prescribed Physical Fitness Parameters.
- Age Senior Division/Wing (Boys/Girls) Up To 26 Years
- Enrolment Period Senior Division/Wing (Boys/Girls) 3 Years
- Height: Minimum Should Be 157.5 Cms. However,
- There Is A Relaxation Of Height For North Eastern Regions Of India.

WHAT TRAINING IS PROVIDED TO NCC CADETS?

- Candidates are trained in drill, shooting, physical fitness, First aid, map reading, sailing and camp training.
- Out of the entire training period, every cadet of the Senior and Junior Division has to undergo service training for a minimum period of 75% of total hours during the annual college and school session, which is compulsory for every cadet except in the case of some medical case.
- Every cadet during the training year to attend an annual training camp of 14 days duration in the case of Senior Division and of 10 days duration in the case of a Junior Division.

The Court Society Moot {MCS} is a dedicated cell, which aims to provide a students to platform to inculcate and enhance advocacy skills. This Society aims to give a chance to all those students who are eager to take participation in National Moot Court. It organizes, through its faculty and students' body, various internal moot court competitions, thereby enabling students to participate in external moot court competitions organized nationally.

The chance to become a member for the moot court society to all those students who are enthusiastic and eager to work as part of the Moot Court Committee of FIMT (SCHOOL OF LAW) NEW DELHI, to take it ahead and strengthen the primary objective of having this committee. The members of the MCC will have a collective responsibility for all the Moot Court work in the college.

The duration of the members shall be for the continuing academic session or till the reconstitution of the next moot court committee. Mooting can best be described as an activity that comes closest to being a lawyer while still studying at law school. It involves identifying legal issues out of a complex factual scenario, doing exhaustive research on those issues to advance arguments with authorities, followed by drafting extensive written submissions and finally the gruelling orals before a bench of eminent judges. In a nutshell, it is everything a lawyer is expected to do once he starts practising law.

MOOT COURT SOCIETY JUSTICE PREVAILS



FIMT SOL organizes moot court competition every year . A moot court competition simulates a court hearing (usually an appeal against a final decision), in which participants analyse a problem, research the relevant law, prepare written submissions, and present oral argument. Moot problems are typically set in areas of law that are unsettled or that have been subject to recent developments.

A Moot Court is an extracurricular activity in which students take part in a simulated court proceeding, which usually involves drafting briefs (or memorials) and participating in oral argument. Moot court and law review are the two key extracurricular activities in which law schools are encouraged to take part. The students taking part in the moot court competition tend to focus on subjects such as public laws, human rights law, international humanitarianlaw, trade law, and international commercial arbitration.

The Moot Court Society (JUSTICE PREVAILS) is a student led initiative, which works hand in hand with the administration for planning, training and executing its activities. 
