The college is easily accessible from several locations throughout the city and boasts a state-of-the-art infrastructure. The college offers several other student rooms and facilities in addition to a well-planned administration block. It has offered various departmental labs as well as independent, well-equipped labs for basic sciences.

LIBRARY and E-LIBRARY: Students have access to different libraries at the campus. The computerization, reprographic capabilities, online journals and periodicals section, computerization, and reference services are all aspects of the library. Access to N-LIST, SCC Online, DELNET, and Manupatra are available.

IT DEPARTMENT: The most up-to-date technological systems are available in the IT Department, often known as the "Computer Labs," where knowledgeable and experienced faculty members train students. In addition to top-notch hardware, all the most recent software needed for application development is available. The college has adopted an Internet leased line facility in order to keep up with the times, and it also offers its students commercial products that support their success in their areas of specialisation. PRODUCTION CONTROL ROOM: Modern equipment, such as a soundproof glass cockpit, a video monitor, a video mixer, various camera settings, cameras, and graphics with digital video effects for editing and enhancing audio and video, are available in the production department along with skilled personnel. The department assists other departments in planning their incredibly amazing video productions with student assistance.

ART, CRAFT & MUSIC ROOM : FIMT provides hands-on training in general art and craft concepts as well as the production of different crafts, including playdough ideas, spin painting, body painting, 3D paintings, stained glass bunting, spin painting, and leaf printing fabric. MEDICAL EMERGENCY ROOM : A Medical Emergency Room has been constructed by the college, in order to promptly treat minor injuries, such as small cuts and wounds, fever, cough, and cold, as it offers full medical courses.

MOOT COURT SOCIETY : FIMT boasts a lively and dynamic mooting community. The student-run Moot Court Society-Justice Prevails collaborates closely with the administration to organise, prepare, and carry out its events. The 31st Bar Council of India All India Inter-University Moot Court Competition was hosted by FIMT, the first and only institution of GGSIPU. Additionally, 44 teams from law schools around the nation competed in the National Moot Court Competition, which was recently organised by FIMT.

TRANSPORTATION FACILITY: The Institute offers CAB/BUS service from various regions of Delhi NCR for students travelling from different parts of Delhi. All of the cars have GPRS enabled for the protection of the students.

LEGAL AID SOCIETY: The National Legal Service Authority (NLSA) and the Delhi State Legal Service Authority (DLSA) oversee the Legal Services Clinic, which was established by the Legal Aid Society. The primary objectives of the organization are to provide legal aid and increase public awareness of the law, with the assistance of paralegal volunteers and legal aid attorneys at the FIMT School of Law's Legal Services Clinic. The Society has given DSLSA training to 100 volunteer para-legals.

CAFETERIA: Students and guests can get fresh snacks, tea, coffee, juice, beverages, and everyday necessities at the institute's large, clean canteen. The mess committee, which consists of representatives from the administration, professors, and students, has specific authority over the food preparation process.

REGULAR UNDER GRADUATE DEGREE COURSES

Bachelor of Business Administration + Bachelor of Legislative Law

BBA - LLB (Integrated) (H)

Duration : 5 yrs.

DESCRIPTION OF DEGREE : BBA-LLB (Integrated) is an undergraduate Administrative Law professional course which is a Higher Academic Standard Course of five years duration with 10 Semesters. It is called an Integrated Course because its course curriculum involves the study of Commerce and Business Administration etc. along with the in-depth study of law and legislature.

SKILL OBTAINED : During the program the students study Financial Accounting, History, Political science, Economics, Sociology, Law of contract, Legal theory, Environmental law, Advocacy skills, Indian Penal Code, Family law, Code of Civil Procedure, Criminal Procedure Code, Business and Commercial Laws, Intellectual Property Rights, Tax Laws, Law of Torts, Banking and Insurance Laws, International Law, International Trade Law. etc.

BA-LLB (Integrated) (H)

During two year teaching programme the students undertake various theoretical and practical topics which helps them in establishing themselves as agents of modernization, social change, promote social cohesion, international understanding, and work for protection of human rights and rights of the child.
