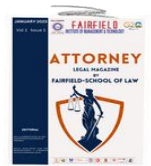

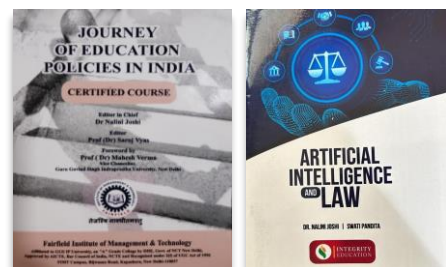

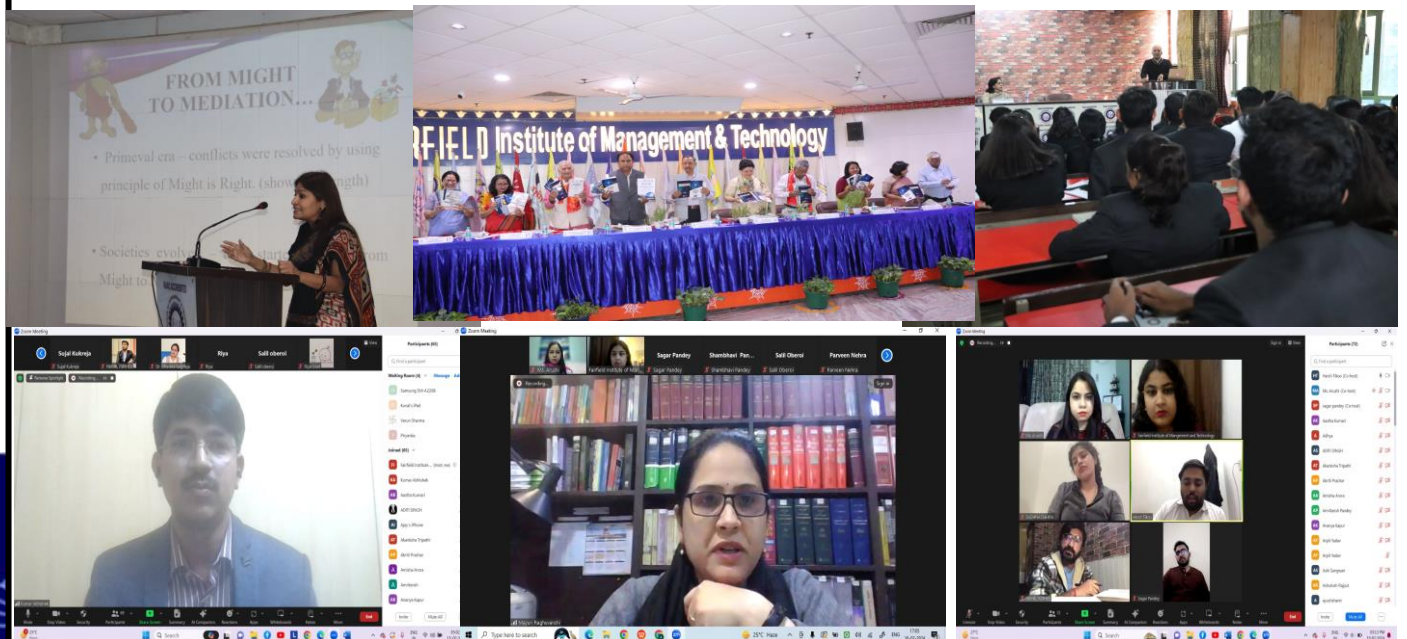

A Pre-Interview Screening Process may include group talks, interviews via phone, written questionnaires, or any other procedure deemed required by the recruiter.

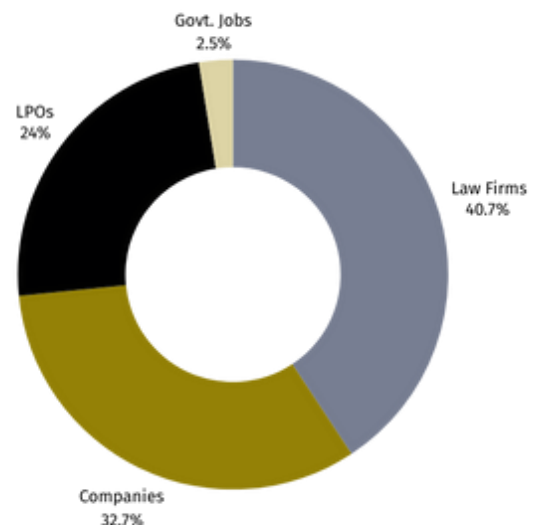
